Program Selections for Service Units

- All workshops are one hour in length.
- Service units using the Service Unit-Led Program Services may select **1-2** programs. Service units must provide the appropriate verification of training prior to leading these activities.
- When choosing the À La Carte program option, service units select **1-2** programs.
- Service units select **3** programs if they chose the Program Trio or NTSW All-Inclusive packages.
- Programs are held on Saturday or Sunday from 10:00-11:00 a.m., 11:15 a.m.-12:15 p.m. and 1:30-2:30 p.m.
 - If you have a larger group, an alternative schedule may be made by the Outdoor Program team.
- Night programs are held on Friday and Saturday nights.
- Depending on group size, your service unit may be divided into subgroups that rotate through the three different programs.
- If selecting programs that work toward badges, girls will not complete the badge during the session. Service units will receive an outcome sheet with the badge steps completed while at camp.
- Program content for all programs *may* differ based on age groups.

Amazing Animals

Max 50 participants per session

Girls will become a young biologist by identifying various animal tracks and making their own animal track to take home. Learn interesting facts about the animals that live around Trefoil Ranch, study the life cycle and food chain of animals, and learn about owls. Using a magnifying glass and tweezers, girls will get to dissect a sterilized owl pellet. They will learn about bones and many other interesting facts.

Girls will work on steps of the Junior Animal Habitats badge and the Junior Outdoor Journey.

Offered Year-round

Leave No Trace and First Aid

Max 50 participants per session

Participants will learn about the 8 Leave No Trace principles and how to be a good outdoor steward. Participants will also learn how to perform some First Aid techniques for injuries that are common outdoors. Each participant will leave the activity with a homemade first-aid kit.

Participants will complete some Girl Scouts of Utah Outdoor Skills Levels 1: Beginner and 2: Intermediate for Daisies and Brownies and Level 3: Advance for Juniors, Cadettes, Seniors, and Ambassadors. Brownies will complete steps 2, 3, and 4 of Brownie First Aid. Juniors will complete step 3 of Junior First Aid.

Offered Year-round

Sun, Moon, and Stargazing

No maximum

Explore the sun, meet the stars, and learn the phases of the moon. Go on a night hike and enjoy stargazing.

Girls will work on steps from the Space Science Explorer, Space Science Adventurer, Space Science Investigator, Night Owl, and Sky badges and Cadette and Senior Outdoor Journeys.

Wild About Art

Max 50 participants per session

Being outside in nature is a great way to spark your creativity. Get ready to observe and collect things outdoors that will drive your art and creativity – from colors and patterns to landscapes and wildlife. Program content will differ based on the season.

Participants will work on steps from the Outdoor Art Creator, Outdoor Art Explorer, and Outdoor Apprentice badges and Daisy Outdoor Journey.

Woodshop

Max 20 participants per session

Enjoy Trefoil Ranch's woodworking shop! Girl Scouts will learn how to sand and use a hammer while creating string art.

Cadettes will work on some of the requirements for the Woodworking Badge.

Explore Archery (2nd grade and above only)

Max 18 participants per session

Are you as brave as Merida? As loyal as Katniss? Archery is an exciting sport that takes strength, focus, good form, and practice. Get ready to challenge yourself as you build your archery skills and shoot at Trefoil Ranch's Archery Range.

Cadettes will work on some of the requirements for the Archery Badge.

Offered only during non-winter months

Snowshoe Adventures

Max 40 participants per session

Join us for an activity that allows us to experience all of winter's beauty: snowshoeing. We will learn about some of the types of snowshoes that have been used and then strap on our own snowshoes which we will use while we hike the trails. While you're on the trails be sure to look for animal tracks and other signs of wildlife. *Program is dependent on weather conditions and snow level.*

Daisies will work on some of the requirements for the Snow or Climbing Adventure Badge. Brownies will work on some of the requirements for the Outdoor Adventure Badge.

Teamwork Doesn't Seem Like Work!

Max 30 participants per session

Do you like participating in challenges that require you to tap into your creative side? Come on down to the Low Ropes Course! The team challenges presented to you at the low ropes course will require some brain power along with some strength! Discover how problem-solving and communication skills are rock-star qualities when it comes to working together and being successful!

Brownies will work on some of the requirements for the Making Friends Badge and Outdoor Adventure Badge.
