

Camp Packing List

Quantities may be adjusted based on length of camper's stay.

Clothing

- 2 pairs of closed-toed, closed-heeled shoes (suitable for hiking in rocky terrain; shoes not meeting this requirement may not be worn around camp)
- Warm sweater or sweatshirt (1-2)
- Pants & shorts (1 pair of pants/shorts per day)
- T-shirts (1 per day plus 1-2 extra) *No tank tops please – sleeves provide sun protection*
- Long sleeved shirt (1-2)
- Underwear (1 per day plus 1-2 extra)
- Socks (1 per day plus 1-2 extra)
- Rain gear (waterproof jacket or poncho)
- Warm pajamas (2)
- Hat with brim
- Swimsuit (recommended) *suitable for camp environment*
- Bandana (recommended)
- Shower shoes (recommended)
- Knit hat (recommended – especially for Camp Cloud Rim)
- Warm coat (recommended – especially for Camp Cloud Rim)

Camp Gear

- Sleeping bag (rated to 20 degrees or cooler)
- Sheet (recommended to cover mattress)
- Pillow
- Warm blanket (recommended)
- Bath Towel
- 24-32 oz. durable water bottle
- Plate/bowl, spoon, and cup for cookouts
- Sunglasses
- Flashlight with new batteries
- Backpack (suitable to carry daily items: water bottle, sweatshirt, etc.)

Optional Equipment

- Camera (not a cell phone)
- Stationary (addressed and stamped)
- Pen/pencil
- Laundry bag
- Stuffed animal
- Book
- Travel games/cards
- Theme week items

Toiletries

It is helpful if toiletries are in an easy-to-carry bag.

- Toothbrush & toothpaste
- Shampoo & conditioner
- Body soap
- Lotion (optional)
- Hairbrush/comb
- Deodorant
- Sanitary supplies
- Lip balm
- Sunscreen (SPF 30+)
- Insect repellent
- Small hand sanitizer

Camp Cloud Rim – additional items

- Water shoes (must have a heel strap) *Camp has extra available if needed*
- Beach towel (2, if in a water-based program)
- Extra swimsuit (if in a water-based program)

Trefoil Ranch – additional for horse programs

- Long pants with no holes (jeans recommended)
- Riding Boots: boots with at least a ½-inch heel and a smooth bottom designed for horseback riding. Fashion boots and other shoes are not permitted while riding. Extra boots are available for campers to borrow for riding; families do not need to purchase boots.

Items to leave at home

- Candy, gum, food, or soda
- Curling irons, blow dryers, straighteners, etc.
- Items packaged in glass containers
- Personal sports equipment (archery equipment, climbing gear, etc.)
- No drugs, weapons, alcohol, or contraband of any kind
- Electronic devices (tablets, smart watches, music players, etc.)
- Cell phones (including watches with calling capabilities)

Electronic items can easily be damaged in the camp environment. If a camper brings these items to camp, they will be labeled and put in the Camp Director's possession until the camper checks out.
