Facts from 2021 GSRI Study

- » Fifty-six percent (56%) of women in the 117th Congress are Girl Scout alums.
- » Seventy-one percent (71%) of current female senators are Girl Scout alums.
- » Fifty-three percent (53%) of current female delegates and representatives in the House of Representatives are Girl Scout alums.
- » Five of the nine current female governors are Girl Scout alums.
- » Every United States female Secretary of State in U.S. history was a Girl Scout or Girl Guide: Madeleine Albright, Condoleezza Rice, and Hillary Clinton.

This confirms what Girl Scouts have known all along: Girl Scouting builds girls and women of courage, confidence, and character, who lead in their lives, at in their communities.
