



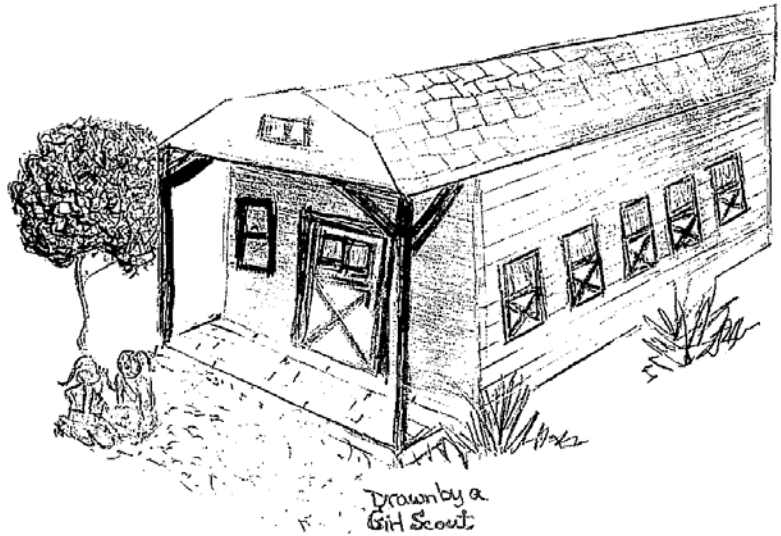

## The Case for Building Bungalows at Trefoil Ranch

Since 1946, **Girl Scouts of Utah's Trefoil Ranch** has been located on 123 beautiful acres tucked away in Provo Canyon, Utah. It is home to GSU's horseback riding program, including 25 horses; girls also enjoy a myriad of other camp activities. Trefoil Ranch is also a year-round program center, offering winter activities such as cross country skiing and snowshoeing.

**Girl Scouts of Utah staff and committees** developed a comprehensive master site plan which includes the building of permanent structures. Across the country, councils have chosen buildings as they introduce camp upgrades. Trends reported by the American Camp Association include the desire for a variety of camping experiences (e.g. tents, lodge, and cabins), flush toilets, closed-door facilities, and increased staff supervision in camp housing.

Bungalows will have electricity and the helping hand of a trained adult will be a doorway away. Separate but adjacent accommodations for camp staff will facilitate the housing of campers, troops and their facilitators, or mother-daughter pairs during the many events and troop camping trips held in addition to resident camp programming. Heat will also be available in the bungalows in colder months. Not only are heated cabins inhabitable year-round, they are permanently in place, and require no annual disassembly for the 50 or more years they are estimated to last. The bungalows will feature slab-on-grade instead of steps, making them handicap accessible.

**In 2009, more than 1,200 girls participated in overnight activities** hosted at Trefoil Ranch, including troop camping trips, mother-daughter nights, Never-the-Same Weekends, and more. Hundreds of adults, whether volunteers, troop facilitators, visiting donors, or interested community members, have also participated in a multitude of programs throughout the year. The building of bungalows at Trefoil Ranch will upgrade a nearly perfect Girl Scout camp as we move into the future and the certain growth of Girl Scouts of Utah Trefoil Ranch program center needs.
