The Details

Dates: April 1 - June 30, 2019

Cost: \$25 per person* (girls and adults)

Paying for girls' (and adult leaders') membership fees is a great use of money earned through the Girl Scout Cookie Program! Financial assistance for the \$25 girl membership fee may be requested by the family members.

* Membership fees go directly to GSUSA and are not refundable.



The Incentives

Girl Early Bird:

Girls who are registered by June 30 receive the Izzy Early Bird patch and the GSUSA Next Step patch. Patches will be mailed to girls in July.

On-Time Event:

Girl and adults must register as a member by September 30 to be eligible to attend the On-Time Fall Festival at Trefoil Ranch on Saturday, October 26.

Troop Early Bird:

* Troops who renew 65% of their girls by June 30 will receive a \$50 Troop Certificate for shop merchandise, programs, and/or council activities.

* Renew ten girls and four adults by June 30 and your troop will receive an additional \$25 certificate. Don't have ten girls? Check out the back page for incentive ideas.

* Renew 85% of girls by September 30, 2019 and receive an additional \$25 certificate.

Additional Troop Incentive:

* Troops must be in good financial standing with no cookie debt, Troop Annual Financial Report submitted by June 30, meet threshold of five girls and two troop leaders to be eligible for the incentives.

Make Early Bird a Tradition in Your Troop!

Renewing every year ensures that your girls' amazing friendships and connections will last them a lifetime. (Plus, who doesn't want matching Early Bird patches every year?) Parents, talk to your Troop Leader about your troop's renewal plans.

- **Be Prepared.** By renewing your girls' membership now, your troop will be ready for another year. You don't have to spend the summer or the first few weeks of the school year chasing down registrations!
- **Communicate.** Let parents/caregivers know about your troop's plans for the upcoming year. Who will be troop leaders? What roles are needed? How can they help?
- **Celebrate!** Troops can invite families to an end-of-year bridging or awards ceremony. Renew everyone that night and share plans for next year.
- **Use Troop Funds.** Pay for the troop's membership fees using Troop Funds. It's easier for everyone, and an excellent use of money earned together all year long!
- **Build your Troop Support!** Early Bird is the perfect time to encourage every adult in your troop to sign up to become a Troop Leader or Troop Supporter so they can help you throughout the year. Ask if anyone is interested in helping your troop.
