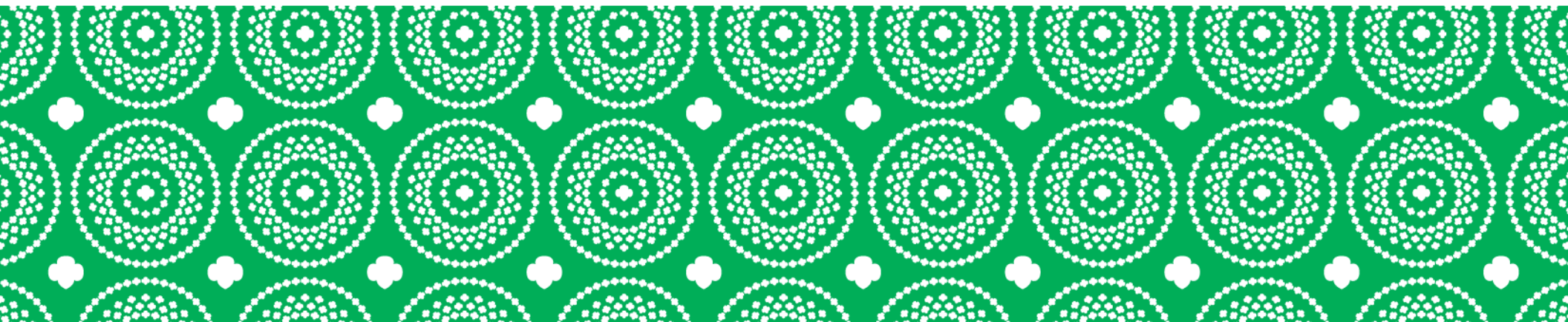

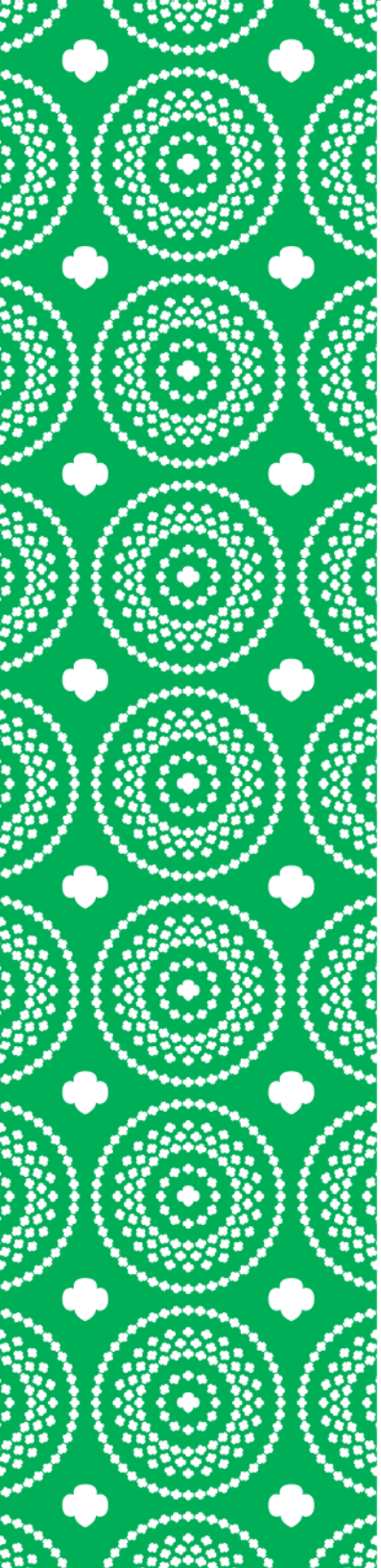
Training Reminder

- Troops/groups should take Planning Extended Trips training at least 6 months prior to national travel and should take Planning International Trips training at least 18 months prior to international travel.

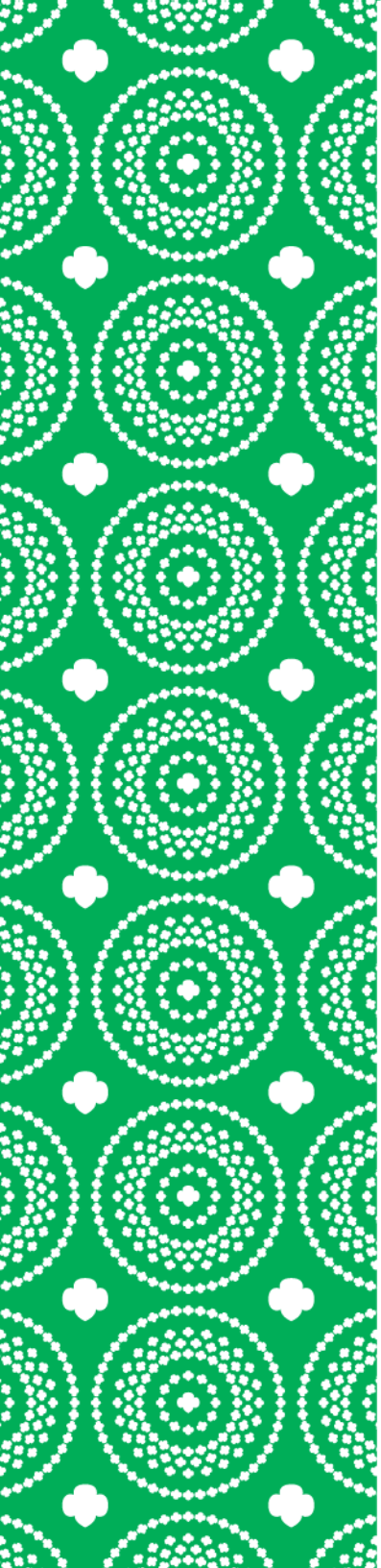
