World Thinking Day for Juliettes

You might think of World Thinking Day as a world fair where troops highlight different countries' foods, clothing, and traditions. But World Thinking Day is so much more! It is a fantastic opportunity for Juliettes to connect with the greater Girl Scout and Girl Guide community. The World Association of Girl Guides and Girl Scouts provides a curriculum packet to help earn the World Thinking Day patch. Here are some tips for completing the packet as a Juliette:

- Complete a discussion between your Juliette and a trusted adult.
- Play games with siblings or cousins, such as the recycling game in the World Thinking Day packet.
- Invite friends over to learn about what you do as a Juliette and participate in activities from the World Thinking Day packet.
