Juliettes in 2023: Recap

Juliettes were busy in 2023! We ended our 2022-23 year with over 400 Juliettes in Utah. They completed badges and Journeys, earned their highest awards, and spent time at camps and events with GSU. Here's some of the 2023 highlights:

- We held a Juliette meetup after our Winter Survival Skills virtual program.
- We had nearly 100 Juliettes sell cookies, coming from every corner of the state.
- We held our first end of year celebration in July, complete with crafts and cake.
- We hosted a Juliette minicamp at Trefoil Ranch in August where Girl Scouts participated in archery, made bandana bags, and spent time with their favorite adult at camp.
- We kicked off the new membership year with our first Juliette Activity packet, including a year planner and activities from the Hispanic Heritage Month patch program.

Packets will be mailed quarterly throughout the membership year, and our next packet will be sent out in January. Juliettes go for the Gold: Juliettes and Highest Awards

Did you know that there are Juliette Girl Scouts who earn their highest awards every year? The Highest awards are the Bronze, Silver, and Gold awards, earned through a sustainable project that addresses a root cause in the community. This year we had multiple Juliettes earn the highest award in Girl Scouting: The Girl Scout Gold Award!

Your Juliette can get started with their highest awards when they become a Junior (4th grade). Juniors can earn the Girl Scout Bronze award, Cadettes can earn the Girl Scout Silver award, and Seniors and Ambassadors can earn the Girl Scout Gold award. You'll start with a Journey, to hone your "Take Action" skills. Then you'll start a special project, working to address a root cause of a problem in your community. Your project should contain a sustainable element that can continue to help the community after your work is done!

Awesome Activities: Cookie Fast Facts

This month's "Awesome Activity" can be used in many of our cookie badges, like Cookie Collaborator for Juniors. In cookie game and quiz show activities, you can use facts about our cookies to create the game. To create a quiz show, like for Cookie Collaborator, you'll want to use our talking points to come up with Fast Facts, like these:

- Six cookies are vegan: Thin Mints, Peanut Butter Patties, Lemonades, Adventurefuls, Caramel Chocolate Chip, and Toast-Yays.
- Caramel Chocolate Chip Cookies are gluten-free and free of allergens like nuts, eggs, and soy.
- Cookies are \$5/box, except the Caramel Chocolate Chip Cookies, which are \$6/box.

Once you have your Fast Facts and have gone over them with your Juliette, quiz your Juliette to help them learn. For younger Girl Scouts, you can give them helpful hints.


Girl Scouts Give Back Day is February 10!
