2023 Camporee Registration Worksheet

This worksheet is a guide of the info you will need to register for Camporee. Having this info before registration opens will help the process operate more smoothly.

Registration opens Monday, February 6 at 12:00 p.m. and closes Wednesday, February 8 at 11:59 p.m. Registration for 2023 is a lottery system and placement is not guaranteed.

Participant Numbers

Troops are expected to follow a 1:5 ratio (one adult to five campers), regardless of age level(s) of Girl Scouts attending. Troops are required to pay for the number of youth and adult spaces reserved during registration (\$75/space). For example, if your troop reserves 12 spots during registration and only 11 people attend, the troop is still responsible for paying for the 12th spot.
