In addition to the national celebration of all Gold Award Girl Scouts at Girl Scouts Change the World on October 9, one Gold Award Girl Scout from each council and USAGSO is being honored with a GSUSA Gold Award Scholarship. And we're thrilled to announce Anna is Girl Scouts of Utah's recipient!

Anna created 20 mindfulness buckets for special education students in four junior high and high schools. These buckets were created for students to build mindfulness and to improve behavior, helping them recognize when they needed to take a

break. They contain sensory items and breathing and reflective exercises to help students calm down and reflect on their actions and emotions.
