

Summer Leadership Programs: Home Edition 2020

Leader-in-Training (LIT)

August 3-7, 2020

Entering grades 9th-12th

- Join us for five days as we focus on the building blocks for all of our leadership programs. Girls will complete an application prior to the session and have a practice group interview on the first day. Throughout the session, girls will learn about leadership, the Camp Program Quality Assessment tool, youth developmental stages, rainy day backup plans, and games without equipment.

Counselor-in-Training 1 & 2 and Wrangler-in-Training 1 & 2 (CIT 1) (CIT 2) (WIT 1) (WIT 2)

June 29-July 2, 2020

Entering grades 10th-12th (Level 1 programs) or grades 11th-12th (Level 2 programs)

- We are combining programs to create a week full of super leadership programs! Girls will spend 4 days enhancing their leadership skills through workshops including camper supervision, home sickness, behavior management, risk management, crisis management, and more. There will be sessions with all programs together as well as breakout sessions to have greater focus on developing specific skills.

Junior Counselor (JC) and Junior Wrangler (JW)

June 16-17, 2020

Entering grade 12

- Gypsy and Chocolate will lead you through 2 days of review and learning new training components such as camper discipline and bully prevention. We will also have a session focused on Virtual Programming, where you will leave prepared to assist the Camp Directors in a variety of our programs we will be hosting for younger girls this summer. After completing the 2 days of training, you will receive more information about virtual program "internships."

Program Details:

- Cost is \$10 per day for all leadership programs. Girls will sign up for the entire session.
- Activity credits can be used to pay camp fees. Activity Scholarships are available.
- Programming will be mainly Zoom video calls, with the potential of other learning avenues as well.
- Most sessions will run from 9am-10am on scheduled program days.
- Whether you can or cannot attend these options in 2020, all girls will automatically qualify for the next leadership program track in 2021.

 - Apply to become a member of the Virtual Outdoor Girl Planning Team (CIT 1/WIT 1 & up).
