

Virtual Troop Camping 2020

Programming will include fun camp programs, Centennial patch programming, Campfire program, Troop Leader Social, and a Saturday morning check-in. Troops will also receive a packet prior to their session with ideas on how to keep their troop virtually camping outside of the GSU scheduled programming. After the event, troops will receive a keep the fun going box complete with exclusive patches for each participant and camp themed items for your next in-person troop meeting.

Session Times

- Virtual programs with the Camp Directors will take place between 10:00 a.m. on Friday through 9:30 a.m. on Saturday. Programs will last 30 minutes – 1 hour with free time in between.

Program Details:

- Troops will sign up for a single date. There is no placement process as in traditional summer troop camping.
- Cost is \$50 for up to 10 registrations. If you have more than 10 girls in your troop, please register for additional troop camping spaces.
- Adults do not need to be counted in registration numbers, unless they want to receive a patch.
- Activity credits can be used to pay camp fees.
- It is recommended parents/guardians attend with 1st-3rd graders.
- Troops should plan to have all girls participate virtually. Troops should not plan to meet at a central location to participate. As of May 6, all in-person meetings for troops are cancelled through June 30, 2020.
- Programming with the Camp Directors will be done through Zoom.
- There will be multiple blocks of free time in the schedule where troops are encouraged to meet together on their own. Troops will receive a packet prior to their session with ideas. - Troops will have the opportunity during registration to choose from one of the following afternoon activities (troops will not be split). Please work with your troop to make your selection:
 - **Games Galore:** Being apart doesn't mean the fun has to end. Participate in a variety of long distance games. From Pictionary to Trivia to Charades, what games lie in store for your troop?
 - **Get Up & Get Moving:** Join us for a half-hour full of being active. Your troop might Zumba, practice Yoga, have a dance off, or more during this session of fun movement.
 - **Gourmet Microwave Cooking with Gypsy:** The microwave isn't just for leftovers anymore. Learn some new recipes you can make using just your microwave or other simple kitchen appliances.
 - **Camp Quest with Chocolate:** Is your troop up to the challenge in competing in the ultimate at-home camp scavenger hunt?
