
Spring Renewal

Why should your troop consider Spring Renewal?

- 1. It's easy with online renewal. Go to myGS, accessible from any page at www.gsutah.org, and log in to renew yourself and your entire troop at one time.
- 2. Cookie proceeds cover the cost. Using the proceeds from the Girl Scout Cookie Program to renew all the girls in your troop gives them the satisfaction of being self-sufficient; they worked hard to earn that money, this is an immediate result.
- 3. You can jump right into the Fall Product Program. Start your year off right by earning funds for girls to use toward even more fun.
- 4. Be prepared to have fun in 2023! Imagine starting the Girl Scout year ready to explore and embark on fun new adventures. Begin thinking about and planning all of the excitement ahead.

- 5. Get your special patch. All girls who renew as part of a troop or an individual girl between April 1 –May 31 will receive our celebratory patch they can wear proudly all year long.
- 6. As a bonus, we're offering fantastic incentives! You'll help your troop and service unit reach their goals.

Program Aide Training (Cadette Girls)

This training is the second part of the three requirements for Cadette girls who wish to earn their Program Aide award.

Cadettes can receive their Program Aide award by earning one LiA award, completing council-designed leadership course training, and working directly with younger girls in a group or troop setting.

PA Training Details:

- American Fork: Friday, April 29 & Saturday, April 30
- Girls need to have completed their LiA before taking this training.
- Must attend both days to complete PA training.
- Council will provide earned PA pin once service hours are completed.

Action needed: Register by April 22, for the Program Aide Training.
