Is mental health on your mind? Join GSU for the Mental Health Awareness patch program on May 14. We'll dive into mental health awareness as we complete the International Bipolar Foundation patch program to learn more about brain-based illnesses, how mental health affects people, and the stigma around mental illness. This program will be hands-on and will include information about coping skills and staying mentally healthy in your life. Younger Girl Scouts (PreK-5 grades) will meet in the morning, and older Girl Scouts (6-12 grades) will meet in the afternoon. Registration ends May 8, so don't delay in signing up.

There will be activities and demos in the Expo Hall, special guests, live performances, and much more. This event is open to all, including Girl Scout members, non-members, alums, and families.

New Council Website Coming in 2023!

Girl Scouts of Utah will soon migrate to a new website to align with the new national site that went live last fall. The content organization and navigation structure will change, and there will be fun colors, shapes, and more photos. The anticipated go-live date for GSU's new site is January 2023.

To prepare our members before the new site goes live, we will share how your user experience will be affected by the content reorganization. We'll show where

volunteers and caregivers can access the information relevant to them, like important forms or upcoming programs.

The goal is to ensure a smooth transition and improve the quality of our website. Toward that end, we are offering our members the chance to provide feedback on the current site so we can try to meet your needs in the new site. There are two opportunities to provide feedback:

- Website Feedback Survey
 - This survey enables you to share what you use our website for, what you like about it, and what you'd change.
 - Note: not all change requests may be implemented in the new site
 - o Open through June 30
- Website Usability Focus Group Interest Form
 - Sign up to be part of a GSU usability study and focus group. *Remote option available for outlying participants*.
 - Select your preferred dates and times to participate in the group.
 - Selected participants will receive an email confirmation with date, time, and an agenda.
 - The focus group will be limited to eight (8) people in-person, five (5) remote, and will not exceed 90 minutes. A snack will be served.
 Participants will receive a gift card as a thank-you.
 - Open until May 27

Action needed: Share your feedback in the <u>Website Feedback Survey</u>. Share your feedback and sign up for the focus group via the <u>Website Usability Focus Group</u> <u>Interest Form</u>. We will select the best representation of our users, i.e., a mix of volunteers and caregivers. Remote option limited to five.

Highest Awards Tip of the Month

One of the defining factors of a Take Action project is that it's sustainable. Sustainability means that the work will continue beyond your involvement and that you have a plan in place that ensures your project makes a lasting change. Having another organization agree to carry on your work or use a curriculum you created is one great method. You could also advocate to change a rule, law or legislation and involve others in your advocacy. Educate others to inspire them to change a behavior or belief and using a measurement tool to show that change is another possibility. However, sustainability will look different for each project, so find the option that will make the most sense for the issue you are addressing.

Action needed: Learn more about earning your Bronze, Silver or Gold Award and the specific requirements for each on our <u>website</u>. The video <u>Take Action to Higher Awards</u> also talks about making projects sustainable.

Planning Ahead – Finance Reports

Troop Finance Reports are due June 30 – Don't wait to start tracking your troop finances on the VTK Finance Tab.

The Finance Tab gives troops the opportunity to track finances online and electronically submit their annual Troop Finance Report. Start with your previous year May 31 bank account balance and begin inputting information to track income and expenses from all the various resources. The Financial Summary will automatically calculate your balances based on what you entered.

Troop Leaders can access the VTK Finance Tab by logging into their <u>myGS</u> account and navigating to the Volunteer Toolkit (VTK) on the left menu. Once in the VTK you will click the Finances Tab and enter all of your troops information.

Never the Same Weekend (NTSW) Reservation Information

Reserve your 2022-2023 NTSW overnight date on Wednesday, May 11, 2022 at 12:00 p.m.!

Never the Same Weekends are opportunities for Girl Scout service units to provide a 24-hour camping experience at Trefoil Ranch (located in Provo Canyon). Service units have the option to provide all their meals and programming, or they can contract with Girl Scouts of Utah's Outdoor Program Team to provide meals and/or programming for their group. Service units determine how much to charge the participants and handle their own registrations. NTSW reservations for October 2022 - September 2023 may be made online on a first-come, first-served basis starting Wednesday, May 11, 2022, at 12:00 p.m.!

NEW! GSU has changed the fees for the initial registration. Instead of charging

one fee for three buildings, GSU is now charging per building per every 24-hour experience. Check out the new fee structure and details below.

- There is a \$200 minimum for every NTSW 24-hour reservation. All service units will automatically reserve the lodge at \$200.
- All other buildings can be added at the time of the reservation.
- Service units can reserve just the lodge during the initial reservation and add more buildings at a later time if those buildings are still available.
- Service units cannot cancel or subtract a building reservation at any time unless they reschedule the entire NTSW experience.
- For service units who reserve a 48-hour NTSW experience, service units can choose to reserve three buildings on the first night and only the lodge on the second night if they like.

Service unit support and buy-in of the Volunteer Toolkit (VTK) are keys to troop leader utilization!

The VTK is the official source for delivering easy and fun troop meetings year-round! This fully customizable digital planning tool is accessible on any computer, tablet, or mobile device and provides you with Girl Scout program content, award requirements, and other resources.
