Troop Leaders can access the VTK Finance Tab by logging into their <u>myGS</u> account and navigating to the Volunteer Toolkit (VTK) on the left menu. Once in the VTK, you will click the Finances Tab and enter all of your troops financial information.

The person in your troop who manages the troop funds should complete this training before submitting your end of year Troop Financial Reports by June 30.
