On-Time Renewal is Underway

It's time to renew your troops for another year of Girl Scout adventure!

Girls who <u>renew their membership</u> between August 1 - September 30 will be entered into a weekly drawing for a \$50 Program Activity Certificate. Drawing winners will be announced weekly on the GSU Program Support Facebook group and in the GSU newsletters.

Troops that renew 100% by September 30 will be entered into a drawing for one of eight Camporee* Fast Passes. That drawing will be held on October 3, and winners will be announced in the October 6 volunteer newsletter and through email.
