Volunteer Toolkit – What's New for 2022-2023!

For Troop Leaders

Explore all year long without starting over! Now the Explore tab adds on to your meeting instead of resetting it. Combine pre-selected tracks or add individual meetings, the choice is yours! If you need to delete your plan and start over, the delete button is on the Year Plan tab.

What else is new?

- Even more information about the Girl Scouts in a troop all in one place, grade, communication preferences, and secondary caregiver information has been added to the My Troop Tab.
- Looking for all the new content in one place? Use the New for 2022-2023 filter when searching for meetings (Explore Meetings or when you Add Badge/Journey) to find everything new in one easy place.
- New Speaker Template! Invite topic experts to share their knowledge and passion with your troop. Use the Speaker invite under Manage Communication on the meeting plan to get started.

New badges are here! View the Badge & Award Chart from the VTK Resources tab and discover all the amazing new and returning Badges, Journeys, and Awards. These newly updated Award Logs and Badge Charts for each grade level replace the versions in The Girl's Guide to Girl Scouting.

The GSU Fall Product Program is an optional council-sponsored program that combines educational activities with money-earning opportunities for troops. The Fall Program is directed toward family and friends - those closest to Girl Scouting and enables troops to earn start-up funds by selling magazine subscriptions, nuts and chocolate.
