## **Required Troop Forms Update**

Be sure you have the current forms and information for your troop kickoff meeting! Every girl should have a Girl Scout Year Parental Permission Form, which includes health history, medical information, and risk of COVID-19 statement.

This form should be kept on record with the troop for the entire Girl Scout year. Troop Leaders should bring a copy of this form to any Girl Scout activity held outside the regular troop meeting location.

This is the ONLY form troop and service units need to gather for activities and events. GSU has retired using the COVID Symptom Checker and Council COVID Assumption of Risk, Release & Waiver.
