Reminder - the Highest Awards Deadline is Approaching

As a reminder, our deadline for all Highest Awards is September 30. If you are still in the same Girl Scout level as last year, you can continue to work on your project and finish it in time for next year's deadline. However, if you bridged to a new level this year (Junior to Cadette or Cadette to Senior), you must turn in your Bronze or Silver Award Final Report by the deadline. The Bronze Award Final Report can be filled out as a troop after the leader checks off the requirements on this rubric. The Silver Award Final Report must be filled out by each individual Girl Scout that worked on the project after the leader checks off the requirements on this rubric.
