



Service Unit Day Camp Coordinator

Summary

The Service Unit Day Camp Coordinator plays an important role in promoting the Girl Scout outdoor experience.

Responsibilities/Duties

- Must take Council Sponsored Event Training, once every 3-years.
- Maintain current knowledge of outdoor opportunities and promote them at service unit meetings.
This might include:
 - Council Outdoor Programs, including resident and troop camping at Camp Cloud Rim and Trefoil Ranch
 - Outdoor adult and girl trainings
 - Outdoor badges
- Work with Event Representative and council Outdoor Program Department to plan and conduct a service unit Day Camp experience for girls.
- Ensure all adult to girl ratios are met for all activities.

Benefits of Service

- Develop leadership skills

Term of Appointment

Appointed by Volunteer Support Specialist and reappointment based on annual evaluation. This position is a minimum one (1) year commitment and is renewable for two (2) consecutive terms, for a total of three (3) years of service. The Girl Scouts of Utah council, in conjunction with the service unit team, will perform an annual evaluation of each service unit team member.
