Application & Approval

- 1-night Trips
 - Submit to service unit
 - 2 weeks prior to trip
- 2+ night Trips
 - Submit application 8
 weeks prior to
 departure

Transporting Girls

- 12 passenger vans are acceptable (no change)
- 15 passenger vans are prohibited, unless professionally operated commercial vans (airport shuttles or similar)

Youth Protection Policies

- •Zero tolerance for abuse of all types
- •Clear guidelines for screening, training, supervision, and evaluation of volunteers and staff
- Appropriate supervision of youth
- Appropriate interactions with youth
- Understanding and reporting child abuse




Youth Protection Training for all GSU staff and volunteers, effective 10/1/2022

Training will be available on gsLearn

- Assigned to all staff and volunteers
- 674 Youth Protection Training

To complete the course, there are five parts:

- 1. A video with Prevent Child Abuse Utah (PCAU) (mandatory)
- 2. Uploading the PACU certificate (mandatory)
- 3. A knowledge check of the GSU Policies Addendum (an optional video or PDF of the policies are available for reviewing)
- 4. A knowledge check of the Resources (a PDF of the resources is available for viewing)
- 5. "eSign" the agreement (required to complete the course)


GSU Fall Recruitment Focus & Success
