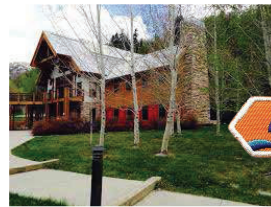

Activity Credit Program

Activity Credits are as valuable as cash. Keep them in a safe place.

Girl Scouts of Utah's (GSU) Activity Credit Program encourages girls to participate in the Cookie Program. Activity Credits give girls the freedom to choose how they participate throughout the year. A girl and her caregivers, not the adult leaders, decide how her Activity Credits will be utilized.

Girls earn \$12.50 in Activity Credits for every 50 packages of cookies

from 50 to 349 packages

0-49 packages: \$0.00

50-99 packages: \$12.50

100-149 packages: \$25.00

150-199 packages: \$37.50

200-249 packages: \$50.00

250-299 packages: \$62.50

300-349 packages: \$75.00

Girls earn \$15.00 in Activity Credits for every 50 packages of cookies

starting at 350 or more packages

350-399 packages: \$90.00

400-449 packages: \$105.00

450-499 packages: \$120.00

500-549 packages: \$135.00

550-599 packages: \$150.00

600-649 packages: \$165.00

650-699 packages: \$180.00

700+ packages: \$15 for every

50 packages increments

Activity Credits earned during this year's Cookie Program will be valid until June 30 of the following year. (i.e., If a girl earned Activity Credits in 2026, they expire on June 30, 2027.) Activity Credits must be redeemed prior to expiration date.

Activity Credits can:

- Pay for council-sponsored program activities, minicamps, day camps, outdoor overnight camp, and GSUSA-sponsored Destinations
- pay for retail shop merchandise at Girl Scouts of Utah & Girl Scouts of Southern Nevada Retail Shop (Change is not given)
- Pay for special order items at Girl Scouts of Utah's retail shop. (Change is not given)
- Pay for merchandise at overnight camp trading post. (Change is not given)
- Pay for girl membership registration fees.
- Be transferred between registered Utah Girl Scouts (except adults).

Activity Credits cannot be:

- Used at other Girl Scout Councils. (Except for Girl Scouts of Southern Nevada Retail Shop)
- Used to purchase Girl Scout Cookies.
- Exchanged for cash
- Used to make payments online
- Reissued if lost or stolen

The app makes it easy for you to take payment from customers purchasing cookies. Girl Scout's sites must be published before logging into the mobile app.

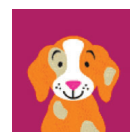
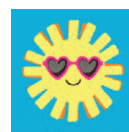


Track Orders and Inventory

Take a few minutes to set your sales goal, write your cookie story, upload a fun picture or video. Then publish and be ready to go!

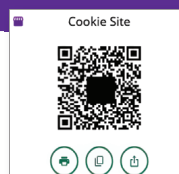
Prepare now by talking with your family about your goals and create a fun video telling customers why they want to support your business.
