Use your voice and collaborate with Girl Scouts from across the nation on the Girl Advisory Board to GSUSA. GSUSA is looking for girls that will be in 7-11 grade in Fall 2023 to join their team. Members of the Girl Advisory Board will make

recommendations, contribute to key initiatives, and influence decision-making processes at the national office. Girl Advisory Board members serve for up to two years or until their high school graduation, whichever comes first.

Program Spotlight: Earn your Global Action Award at Global Girls

Taking action on the global level starts right here at home. Sign up for Global Girls on May 6 and learn how Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) can be applied in your own community. The SDG's are [17 Sustainable Development Goals](#), which are an urgent call for action by all countries - developed and developing - in a global partnership.

We'll focus on SDGs 3 and 11, health and wellbeing, alongside sustainable cities and communities. You'll earn and receive your Global Action Award by attending. We have a morning session for grades 6-12 and an afternoon session for grades K through five. Girl Scouts in grades K-5 can also sign up to help the younger Girl Scouts with their activities after earning their own award in the morning.
