These events will get your Girl Scouts outdoors and enjoying nature. Celebrate Earth Month will focus on eco-science activities like conservation, plants, and earth science. The Earth Day Service Project will include a short eco-science lesson, including a take-home project, followed by a service project to plant native plants

at the SLC office. Both events are family-friendly, so register your non-Girl Scout siblings as "girl nonmembers."

Cornelia Benton Scholarship deadline is less than a month away

The Cornelia Benton Scholarship was started in 1991, thanks to lifetime Girl Scout "Cornie" and has continued as a scholarship opportunity for active, high school senior Girl Scouts to apply for financial aid for their continued education. This prestigious scholarship is awarded based on service, leadership skills, and awards and doesn't consider academic grades or test scores.

The application period for this year's Cornelia Benton Scholarship is now open, and completed applications must be turned in by April 4. The scholarship is eligible to graduating high school seniors who are current Girl Scouts of Utah members and have been actively registered for six or more years. Please note that a letter of recommendation is also due with the application. The complete list of requirements can be found on GSU's website under Scholarships.
