With summer right around the corner, we know our troops are anxious to get out and travel. If planning an overnight trip of two-plus nights, you'll need to have your trip approved by GSU. Applications are due at least two months before your trip dates but can be submitted sooner. Once you apply, a GSU staff member will contact you about additional paperwork needed for approval. Any added paperwork requested will be due one month before the trip dates. Remember to consult the <u>Safety Activity Checkpoints</u> for any planned activities requiring additional council approval, and turn in the <u>Activity Approval form</u> when the requirement is specified.

Action needed: Turn in your <u>trip application</u> at least two months before your trip dates and check the <u>Events Calendar</u> for any upcoming travel trainings needed for your troop trip. Brush up on any other requirements needed for your trip on the **Travel section** of our website.
