Summer Trip Application Reminders

As we gear up for summer adventures, don't forget to turn in your troop trip applications!

- <u>Trip applications</u> must be submitted at least two months prior to the trip date (earlier submissions highly recommended) to ensure ample processing time.
- All required trip paperwork must be submitted at least one month in advance for approval (early submission strongly encouraged).
- If your trip extends for two or more nights, be sure to obtain approval from the Council.

Before setting off, ensure all required training courses are completed. At least one adult on the trip must hold a CPR/First Aid certification with an in-person skills check.

Looking ahead, troops planning international trips for 2026 should consider submitting applications now to utilize activity credits. Remember, activity approvals can take time, so secure them well in advance to avoid any delays. For further details on travel safety, consult the Safety Activity Checkpoints and Volunteer Policies. Let's make this summer's adventures unforgettable for all the right reasons!
