

# Girl Scout Group Camp Rentals

## Never the Same Weekends and Troop Rentals at Trefoil Ranch

Adventure awaits at Trefoil Ranch! Our updated rental package makes it easy for service units and troops to plan a fun, safe camping adventure where Girl Scouts can explore the outdoors, build confidence, and make lasting memories.

### Section 1: Registration Information

#### How to Reserve Dates

Available dates for August 2026 to May 2027 Never the Same Weekends and Troop Rentals are available on the [Trefoil Ranch Facility Calendar](#).

- Service Unit Never the Same Weekend reservations open April 15.
- Troop Rental reservations begin May 1.

Rentals are 4:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. the following day. *Service unit volunteers can arrive at 3:00 p.m. to set up.*

To reserve:

- Submit the [reservation request form](#) to select your rental dates, facilities, services, activities, and registration needs.
- Create an [UltraCamp](#) account if you do not already have one.
- Reservations are processed on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Once confirmed, groups have one week to pay facility fees to secure the reservation.
- Reservations close four weeks before rental dates.

#### Facilities

Trefoil Ranch is a shared property, and multiple groups may be on-site at the same time. Your group will have exclusive use of any reserved facility space.

Bunk House	Upper & lower levels; sleeps 42 (metal bunk beds with mattresses). Includes restrooms, lounge, fireplace. Upper kitchen (full); lower kitchen (stovetop only, no oven).	42	\$100

Circle K Cabin Unit	Three cabins; each sleeps 10 (metal bunk beds). Includes fire pit, picnic table, washstand, nearby restrooms with electricity. One group per unit.	30	\$75 per cabin <i>(max 3 cabins)</i>
Rocking P Cabin Unit	Three cabins; each sleeps 8 (metal bed frames). Includes fire pit, picnic table, washstand, nearby restrooms with electricity. One group per unit.	24	\$60 per cabin <i>(max 3 cabins)</i>

### General Services

Enhance your stay with optional services such as programming, meals, and specialty activities. Availability may vary based on group size, schedule, and facility requirements.

Full-Service Program	Includes all programming and meals for your stay. Activities are seasonal and may include outdoor badge work or GSU's Outdoor Skills Patch program, plus one adventure activity* (based on group size, age, and season).  <i>Service units booking the full-service program receive the Never the Same Weekend Package lodging fee at no cost.</i>  <i>*Adventure activities listed in the next section.</i>	30-174 people	\$65 per person
Food Service	Includes dinner, breakfast, and lunch. The Lodge must be rented to use GSU food service. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Dinner: spaghetti, vegetable, canned fruit, cookies</li> <li>Breakfast: French toast sticks, bacon, scrambled eggs, fruit, coffee, milk</li> <li>Lunch: chicken nuggets, mac &amp; cheese, fruit, salad bar</li> </ul>	45-174 people	\$35 per person
Outdoor Cooking Tub	Provides essential cooking equipment. Groups must supply their own food and consumable items.		\$25
Build-a-Bear Workshop	Includes a Build-a-Bear Workshop experience and one bear. Accessories available for an additional cost. Plan for 20-minute time blocks per 5 bears.	10-60 people	\$28 per person



### Adventure Activities (Led by GSU Staff)

Add guided outdoor experiences led by trained GSU staff.

- A minimum of 3 total programming hours is required for activities to run.
- Each activity requires 10–20 participants per time block.
- Activities are subject to weather and staff availability.

Low Ropes Course	Team-based challenges that build communication, problem-solving, and leadership skills.	None	1 hour	\$100
Bouldering	Low-height climbing without ropes, focusing on balance, strength, and technique.	None	1 hour	\$100
Climbing Wall	Roped climbing experience with varying difficulty levels to build skills and confidence.	2 <sup>nd</sup> grade	2 hours	\$200
High Ropes Course	Elevated obstacles that challenge confidence, teamwork, and personal growth.	4 <sup>th</sup> grade	3 hours	\$350
Slingshots	Target-based activity that develops aim, focus, and coordination.	None	1 hour	\$100
Archery	Guided instruction in archery with a focus on technique and target shooting.	2 <sup>nd</sup> grade	1 hour	\$100
Archery Badge	Archery program designed to meet badge requirements for Cadettes.	6 <sup>th</sup> grade	2 hours	\$150
Hatchet Throwing	Supervised target throwing activity focused on safety, accuracy, and technique.	6 <sup>th</sup> grade	1 hour	\$150

### Group Led Programming

Some adventure activities may be led by trained volunteers.

- Volunteers must complete activity-specific training (except snowshoeing).
- GSU offers annual training (typically the first weekend in October), valid for two years.

## Registration Support

For Never the Same Weekends, service units may request that GSU manage event registration in myGS at no additional cost.

## Section 2: Adult Requirements, Training, and Certifications

### Adult Requirements

To ensure the safety of all Girl Scouts, every adult in attendance must:

- be a registered Girl Scout member,
- have a current background check on file, and
- be up to date on Youth Protection Training.

No exceptions.

### Camping 101 Training

Camping 101 is encouraged but not required for groups at Trefoil Ranch due to on-site support from the Camp Ranger and being on Girl Scouts of Utah-owned property.

### First Aider

Each group must have a designated First Aider with current First Aid and CPR/AED certification (see Volunteer Essentials).

### Food Handler's Permit (groups providing their own meal service)

Groups providing their own meals must have at least one adult (18+) with a current Utah Food Handler Permit, as required by American Camp Association standards.

## Section 3: Payments and Cancellations and Refunds

### Payments

- Facility fees are due within 7 days of confirmation to secure your reservation.
- Fees for services, activities, patches, and badges are due at least 2 weeks prior to your rental.

Failure to pay by deadlines will result in cancellation of the reservation or selected services.

### Cancellations and Refunds

#### Facility Fees

- Fully refundable up to 20 business days prior to your rental.
- Within 20 business days, fees are non-refundable but may be applied to a rescheduled date (August 2026 – May 2027), based on availability.

#### Services, Activities, and Retail Items

- Fully refundable up to 10 business days prior to your rental.
- Non-refundable after that deadline.

### Weather Cancellations

In cases of inclement weather, GSU and group leaders will determine whether cancellation is necessary. GSU will work with the group to reschedule or provide a full refund if rescheduling is not possible.

## Section 4: Trefoil Ranch Property User Guide

Before your visit, volunteers will receive the Trefoil Ranch Property User Guide. Leaders are expected to review and follow all guidelines during their stay.
