	Cookie Program	Serve as the Troop Product Manager for cookies	
	Fall Product Program	Serve as the Troop Product Manager for fall products	
	Take Action Project Coordinator	Help troop leaders and girls plan and complete projects to benefit their community	
	Outdoor Skills	Take troop camp training and serve as the troop's qualified troop camper	
	Chaperone/Driver	Transport or chaperone a group of girl scouts to field trip locations; must have a valid driver's license and vehicle insurance	
	Troop First Aid/ Certifications	Serve as troop first aid person, lifeguard, or canoe certified volunteer	
	Other	 Shop for troop supplies or prep needed materials Research and teach girls a skill Share a musical talent with girls Watch leaders' other children while the troop leaders focus on the girls 	
	Troop Rep	Represent the troop's interests at service unit meetings, which happen once a month	
	Troop Leader and Co-Leader	Any girl with a parent or guardian in a troop leader role will automatically qualify
