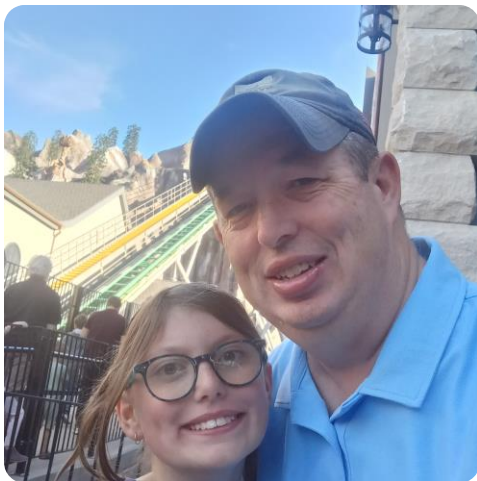

Service Unit Awards & Nominations

Show the volunteers in your service unit just how much you appreciate them with a nomination for a Service Unit Award.

Nominations must be submitted by the **last Friday in March**. Be sure to include the person(s) complete name, award name, your name as the nominator, and a brief description of why the person(s) deserves the award. Some awards also require letters of endorsement; see the full [awards description and criteria](#) (PDF).

Anyone can submit an award nomination. Service Unit Awards are reviewed by the Recognition and Delegate Representatives, then approved and presented by the Service Unit Leadership Team. Learn how to [write a strong nomination](#).

Certificate of Appreciation	For service of exceptional quality from an individual or a group; great for first or one time contribution
Special Supporters Certificate	For honoring groups or individuals for ongoing or a second contribution
Noteworthy New Leader Certificate	For outstanding service by new Troop Leaders or Co-Leaders in their first two years in the role
Service Unit Girl Scout Family Award Certificate	For outstanding contributions by girls and their family to their service unit
Outstanding Volunteer Certificate	For recognizing continued dedication and contributions beyond a troop by a volunteer.
Emerald Award Certificate & Pin	For an adult volunteer whose service to their troop and/or service unit exceeds expectations

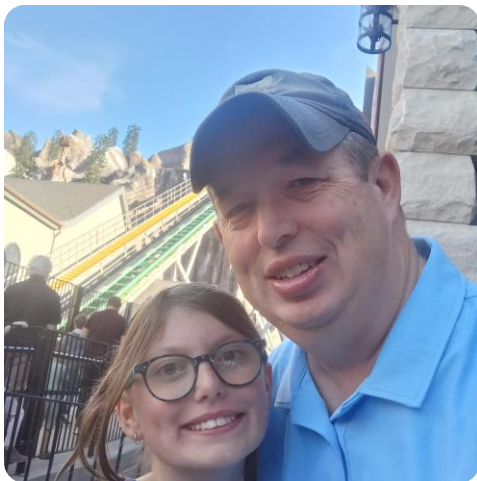

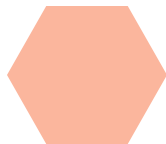
Reminder SU Support

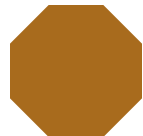

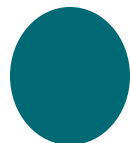
