We are thrilled to share the incredible success of our recent event, Camping for a Cause, which raised an impressive \$71,000+ for camperships (camp scholarships) to support girls in need in Utah. This year's event exceeded all expectations, bringing together a vibrant community of women who are united by a shared commitment to empowering young girls through the transformative experience of camp.

Highlights of the Friday evening schedule of events included an engaging speech about the impact of camperships on her own life from Girl Scouts of

Utah's Board Chair, Joelle Creager. We also debuted a <u>newly produced video</u> <u>featuring our two iconic camps</u> and the impact that summer camp has had on generations of women in Utah since the 1930s. The generosity of our guests during the Paddle Raise donation program that followed these touching Girl Scouts of Utah tributes was truly heartwarming with over \$31,000 raised in less than ten minutes.

Also, a successful silent auction was held on Friday night, which featured hundreds of donated goods and services from local businesses, artists, and nonprofits from all over Utah. We extend our deepest gratitude to all the organizations and people who contributed to our silent auction and made that fundraising possible.

Following their evening of unprecedented generosity, our guests woke up on Saturday morning to a picturesque mountain sunrise over Lake Brimhall, ready to enjoy their day of traditional Girl Scout activities – from hiking and kayaking, to hat making and cookie art.
