# **Utah Day of the Girl - Girl Speaker**

excited to feature Emma Casey as our
Girl Scout Speaker. A lifelong Girl Scout
and a first-year student at the
University of Utah, Emma's journey
began as a Daisy, where she embraced
cookie sales, entrepreneurship, and
outdoor adventure.

Emma loved attending summer camp

at Trefoil Ranch and Camp Cloud Rim, where she developed leadership skills as a Leader-in-Training (LIT) and Counselor-in-Training (CIT). Of all her experiences, Girl Scout STEM programming had the greatest impact, guiding her toward a STEM-focused education at AMES High School and a visit to the Girl Scout STEM Center of Excellence at Camp Whispering Cedars in Northeast Texas.

Emma's dedication to Girl Scouts is reflected in her words: "Girl Scouting has given me confidence in my leadership abilities and helped me understand that

stepping outside my comfort zone is the best way to grow."

The Leadership Summit is Girl Scouts of Utah's annual signature event dedicated to enriching and supporting our key administrative volunteers. This August, 63 Service Unit volunteers gathered at Trefoil Ranch for an inspiring weekend. The theme for this year's event, "You Are the Inspiration," was a heartfelt nod to the dedication and impact of our volunteers.

The program kicked off with presentations by CEO Lisa Hardin-Reynolds and Board Chair Joelle Creager, who shared updates on how we are moving GSU's mission forward. We were also honored to have Jess Burns Lee, Board Chair Emeritus of Safe Zone Utah, speak on creating safer spaces for LGBTQ+ individuals through education and advocacy.

Volunteers participated in a variety of breakout sessions and presentations focused on key topics in the world of girls. One of the highlights was the popular "We're HEAR for You" session, a listening forum led by our CEO and Board Chair, where volunteers could share their insights, ask questions, and engage with our executive leadership. designed to help our volunteers maintain on-brand public awareness efforts.

After a full day of learning and collaboration, we celebrated the achievements of Service Units that went above and beyond in delivering the Girl Scout Leadership Experience and growing our membership. The weekend closed with a traditional friendship circle, leaving everyone rejuvenated and inspired to build girls of courage, confidence, and character in the year ahead.

# Tanya Yu: Juliette Low Seminar



Tanya Yu, a recent Girl Scout alum and current data science student at the University of Utah, is making us proud once again! You may remember her inspiring speech at last year's Utah Day of the Girl. This month, Tanya is headed to Ghana to participate in the Juliette Low Seminar (JLS), a global leadership development program for Girl Guides and Girl Scouts aged 18-30. Since 1932, the JLS has been providing life-changing, intercultural experiences that build global competence and strengthen young women's leadership skills. This year's theme is Peace, and participants like Tanya will focus on creating meaningful connections, supporting their communities, and speaking out against injustice.

Over the last nine months, Tanya engaged in online learning and is now ready to attend the in-person event in Ghana. With 150 participants from 70 countries, the JLS empowers young women to be empathetic global citizens who celebrate diversity and work together for an equal, inclusive world. Tanya is excited to immerse herself in a new culture while staying connected to Girl Scouts, a

At Antelope Island, 106 enthusiastic participants rolled up their sleeves for trail maintenance and helped prepare and paint the metal corrals and fences, followed by self-guided exploration time in the park and an awe-inspiring look at the night sky.

Meanwhile, Wasatch Mountain State Park was so popular it filled up completely, leaving eager attendees on a waiting list! Participants contributed to a service project focused on park maintenance, followed by an astronomy program led by a knowledgeable ranger.

At both events girls shared a meaningful experience, blending outdoor stewardship with a deeper connection to nature.
